Description of the Award

The TILG EEO/AA Practitioner Award recognizes the accomplishments of an individual for his or her leadership, contributions, and commitment to promoting equal opportunity and affirmative action in employment.

Eligibility Requirements

Nominees for this award must be:

- An EEO/AA professional with at least 10 years of experience in the field of equal employment opportunity and affirmative action,
- An employee of a federal contractor or subcontractor with a written affirmative action program(s),
- An individual from an organization that has a current membership with the Triangle Industry Liaison Group (TILG), and
- An individual who has demonstrated commitment to EEO/AA through programs or initiatives they influenced, championed, and implemented which had impactful results.

The first TILG EEO/AA Practitioner Award will be presented at the September TILG membership meeting. Individuals may self-nominate, or the nomination may be from an interested party from an organization that is a current TILG member. The award can only be received once, however, nominees not selected can be re-nominated. Please submit nominations on the attached form no later than August 3, 2018.
